Four Pune-Mumbai trains cancelled on May 2:

The Deccan Express (1007/1008), Pragati Express (2126/2125), Manmad-Pune Express (1025/1026) and the Pune-Karjat passenger train (1618/1617) will not run on May 2, as work is being done on the section between Talegaon and Badlapur. In addition, six local trains running between Pune and Lonavla will not run the Talegaon-Lonavla stretch and the Kolhapur-CSTM-Kolhapur Sahyadri Express and Koyana Express will not run the Pune-CSTM stretch.
